# The First Graduating Class of the Local Leadership Initiative

The Local Leadership Initiative, new in 2023, is a partnership between Leadership Greater Syracuse and Syracuse University's Whitman School of Management. On April 5, the program graduated its first cohort of students.

Over the fall and spring semesters, 12 Whitman students participated in a six-part program designed to increase their awareness of that CNY has to offer, build connections with key leaders, augment leadership and project management skills, and promote giving back to the Syracuse community. In addition, the diverse class with students from those as close as Liverpool and as far away as Greece fostered relationships and taught students how to work creatively with those who are different from them.

Sara Garvey, Director, Corporate Relations at Whitman School said, "It was fantastic to watch students grow and flourish throughout the program while being exposed to all that the Syracuse community has to offer. It opened their eyes to the economic growth and possibility for the future in Central New York."



The six class days (4-6 hours in length) followed many of the same themes as the LGS flagship program—DEI, education, economic development, and more. Participants visited local businesses such as VIP Structures, Salt City Market, Acropolis Realty, and the Samaritan Center. They learned from key community leaders and entrepreneurs in the area to help broaden their perspectives as they make plans for entering the workforce.

"A goal of this program is to educate students about all that Syracuse has to offer and encourage them to invest their talents and ambition locally to help build generations of successful employees and community members," Michele Diecuch, LGS executive director, said.



### LGS Class of 2024 is Underway

The flagship program Class of 2024 has begun!

A group of 51 individuals from 48 CNY employers are participating this year. Starting off with a full agenda at the two-day opening retreat at the Rosamond Gifford Zoo, class members will participate in nine themed class days through the year including: Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Day; Education Day; Envisioning the Future Day; and more.

Participants will be immersed into the current and historical affairs on the CNY area while they develop leadership skills and learn about civic engagement opportunities that will help our community thrive.



Funded through a grant by local business leader David Panasci, the Local Leadership Initiative is a three-year program with year two set to begin in September 2024.
