

CNY Political Leadership Institute

Held annually over eight evenings, CNY PLI is a nonpartisan training about running for local office, volunteering for a campaign, or simply learning how local government works.

Nourishing Tomorrow's Leaders

LGS is a proud partner of this program run by The Gifford Foundation. NTL is an annual, eight-week comprehensive training about all aspects involved in being a nonprofit board member--with an overall goal of increasing the diversity of nonprofit boards across CNY.



Local Leadership Initiative

The Local Leadership Initiative, a partnership between LGS and Syracuse University, is an eight-week program for Whitman School students that teaches them all about CNY while helping them learn their leadership styles--with the goal of encouraging students to stay in CNY upon graduation.
